

RYDE SCHOOLS SPECTACULAR CHOIR 2022

Your child has indicated interest in participating in the combined schools' choir at the Ryde Schools' Spectacular 2022. The Ryde Schools' Spectacular is an annual concert held at the Opera House. The concert is an opportunity for students from Northern Sydney Region Primary and Secondary Schools to join together to provide musical and dance performances.

This year the Ryde Schools' Spectacular will be held on **Monday October 24th**. To be eligible to participate in the Ryde Schools Spectacular Choir, students must attend four combined choir rehearsals:

Monday June 27th at Beaumont Rd Public School 9:45 am - 2:30 pm Monday August 1st venue yet to be confirmed 9:45 am - 2:30 pm Monday September 5th venue yet to be confirmed 9:45 am - 2:30 pm **Friday** September 23rd at the Sydney Opera House 8:30 am - 12:30pm

Students will share a bus with Ermington Public School to travel to the venues.

The total cost of participation in the event is yet to be finalised (as we are waiting on the rehearsal venues). Based on past experiences, the cost is likely to be approximately \$120. This includes: travel to rehearsal venues and a participation fee of \$50 for the concert. This participation fee includes a 'Spectacular' T-shirt worn at the concert (with long black pants). In the past, tickets to watch the performance have been \$45 each. (Money for tickets will be collected late in Term Three.) Please note there is usually a maximum of 2 tickets per performer.

If you give permission for your child to participate in this fabulous opportunity, please complete the return slip below and make payment of an initial \$50 to the school account. Please include your child's T-Shirt size on the return slip below and return to school by Thursday June 23rd.
