NAPLAN

Congratulations to all our Year 3 and Year 5 students who participated in the school's first NAPLAN Online assessments. Whilst there were numerous media reports surrounding technical issues across the country, our ICT lab identified minimal issues. Our students demonstrated patience, cooperation and their personal best during the assessments and I thank our teachers for their professionalism working through the process. Schools will be sent results sometime late Term 3.

Premier's Sporting Challenge

Once again Melrose Park Public School has registered to participate in the NSW Premier's Sporting Challenge. The purpose of the Challenge is to encourage students and staff to participate in sport and physical activity to lead a healthy lifestyle.

Throughout Term 2 staff and students will be monitoring physical activity levels during class time, at recess and lunch as well as during sport lessons. Physical activity outside school hours will also count towards the Challenge award. The aim is to work towards an average at least 60 minutes of activity a day for ten weeks. We would like to invite families to support us in encouraging students' healthy use of leisure time and to experience the joy of being active together. Each student in years 3-6 will be issued with a logbook to record their daily physical activity. Whilst K-2 students will work towards a Gold class award level. Physical activity is valued for its physical, social and emotional benefits. It also helps young people to develop communication skills, confidence and resilience.
