



Class Requirements Year 3 and Year 4 2025

December 2024

Many parents like to have their child ready for school on the first day of the new year. Listed below are some basic items that will be needed to function effectively in class. Most of these items are consumables. The list below should include enough of the consumables to last the entire year. There are many opportunities with BACK TO SCHOOL specials that help keep costs to a minimum. Only these basic stationery items are required. Other items (such as fancy rubbers) will be sent home for home use as they can become distracting for students.

The requirements for Year 3 and Year 4 are:

1 small pencil case which will be kept on the desk containing:

- 2 HB pencils (No mechanical pencils please. Preferably Staedtler, Faber Castell, Crayola or another quality brand)
- 2 green ball point pen for marking
- 2 red ball point pen for marking
- 1 plain white rubber (e.g. Staedtler or Faber Castell)
- 4 highlighters in Big Write colours: yellow, pink, blue & green
- 2 thin whiteboard markers
- piece of material to clean whiteboard (e.g. small odd sock)
- plus a 30cm wooden or rigid plastic ruler (metric only with cm and mm divisions)

Plus

- 1 plastic A4 wallet folder
- homework exercise book 64 pages (named)
- Child size headphones for use with the computer and iPads (stored in labelled snap lock reusable bag)
- library bag
- painting shirt (old adult sized T-shirt with no buttons)
- raincoat (needed to walk to toilets, library, excursions, **no umbrellas allowed**)
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- Roll on sunscreen and roll on insect repellent (individual size and named)

1 labelled snap lock reusable bag to be kept in their tray containing:

- Barrel pencil sharpener that can hold pencil shavings
- 6 spare HB pencils
- 2 spare ball point pens for marking (green and red)
- 8 spare thin whiteboard markers
- Packet of 12 coloured pencils
- Packet of 12 textas
- 4 LARGE Glue sticks (not coloured)
- Scissors (child size)

Please put your child's name on everything including clothing, lunch boxes and school bag. Lunch boxes need to be of a size that can be easily removed from school bag. Please consider a 'litter free/nude food' lunch box.

These items are not compulsory and all students will be able to access their learning using school resources. Thank you for your assistance.
