



## Canberra Excursion 2019 – Final Information

**Departure:** Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> June 6:15 am. **Arrive by 6:00 am** to load the bus.  
Be aware the first meal provided is dinner. Please ensure your child has enough food for the day.

**Return:** Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> June, approximately 8:00 pm.

**Medication:** should be handed to Mrs O'Neill in a 'zip lock' bag, clearly marked with name and completed 'administering prescribed medication' form.

**Payment:** All payments should now have been made.

### Monday

*As the students will be attending Parliament House on this day, all students must wear **a clean full school uniform (named)**.*

Please ensure your child has a small backpack to be taken on the bus, please include:

- One or two school jackets (current Canberra temperature is 4-16 degrees)
- A raincoat
- A healthy recess, lunch and afternoon snack
- A refillable drink bottle (water)
- A wallet with up to \$50 for dinner on the return bus trip and small souvenirs
- Book to read
- Optional – deck of cards, camera only (no mobile phones)

Please pack a small overnight bag containing:

- Pyjamas
- Toiletries – toothbrush, toothpaste, soap
- Two sets of casual clothes including a warm jacket, shoes and hats (One set for Tuesday and one set for Wednesday)
- NO sheets, towels, (supplied by hotel).

*Note: The overnight bag will not be accessible until the students arrive at their accommodation as it will be stored in the bus storage compartment.*

### Tuesday

Students are able to wear casual clothes on this day such as a T-shirt, jumper and jeans in a clean and presentable order. (No t/shirts with slogans or inappropriate motifs.) It is cool in Canberra.



## Wednesday

Students are able to wear casual clothes on this day such as a T-shirt, jumper and tracksuit pants in a clean and presentable order. (No t/shirts with slogans or inappropriate motifs.) Note that students will be at an outdoor camp for part of the day, so clothes need to be suitable for climbing ropes courses and other outdoor activities.

- The students will be supervised on the excursion by Mrs O'Neill, Ms Wondracz and Mr Steel.
- The school's mobile number is 0467 761 086 for after-hours emergency use only.
- All items of clothing including their school uniform and other belongings need to be labelled with their name.
- Students **should not bring** electronic devices or games, mobile phones, smart watches, soft drinks, lollies, etc.
- Once students arrive at the hotel they will stay in their own rooms.
