Class Requirements Year 5 and Year 6 2022

December 2021

Many parents like to have their child ready for school on the first day of the new year. Listed below are some basic items that will be needed to function effectively in class. Most of these items are consumables. The list below should include enough of the consumables to last the entire year. Teachers will collect the supplies and distribute to students at the start of each term. There are many opportunities with BACK TO SCHOOL specials that help keep costs to a minimum. Only these basic stationery items are required. Other items (such as fancy rubbers) will be sent home for home use as they can become distracting for students.

The requirements for Year 5 and Year 6 are:

1 small pencil case which will be kept on the desk containing:

- 2 black or dark blue ball point pens (fine)
- 2 green ball point pens
- 5 HB pencils
- 1 plain white rubber (e.g. Staedtler or Faber Castell)
- 4 highlighters in Big Write colours: yellow, pink, blue & green
- 2 thin whiteboard markers
- 1 fine permanent marker (e.g. Sharpie)
- Piece of material to clean whiteboard (e.g. small odd sock)
- 30cm ruler (metric only with mm divisions) No metal rulers allowed
- 1 labelled snap lock reusable bag to be stored in their tray containing:
- Pencil sharpener with a container
- 2 <u>thin</u> whiteboard markers
- Pkt of 12 textas
- Pkt of 12 coloured pencils
- 2 LARGE Glue sticks (not coloured)
- Scissors

Additional labelled snap lock reusable bag stored for Semester 2 containing:

- 6 black or dark blue ball point pens (fine)
- 2 green ball point pens
- 10 HB pencils
- 2 plain white rubbers (e.g. Staedtler or Faber Castell)
- 4 highlighters in Big Write colours: yellow, pink, blue & green
- 6 thin whiteboard markers **Plus**
- 3 plastic A4 wallet folders
- Protractor and compass
- Headphones for use with the computer and iPads (in a snap lock reusable bag)
- Homework A4 non spiral exercise book 64 pages (covered and named)
- Library bag
- Painting Shirt (old adult sized T-shirt with no buttons)
- Raincoat (needed to walk to toilets, library and excursions. No umbrellas allowed)
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- Roll on sunscreen and roll on insect repellent (individual size and named)
 Please put your child's name on everything including clothing, lunch boxes, stationery and school bag. Lunch boxes need to be of a size that can be easily removed from school bag.
 Please consider a 'litter free/nude food' lunch box.
