#### Walking Excursions (K-6)

Students will be participating in local walks to enhance activities completed in class. These excursions will support important parts of the English, Science and Technology and Geography units that the students are studying. To ensure that we make the most of our local environment, rather than plan the dates of these walks weeks in advance, teachers will notify parents of the dates of walks ahead of time in the school newsletter and through class notes. Students will be accompanied on any walk by their class teachers with first aid and emergency care training.

#### Seed Harvest Spoon (K-6)

This program is held at school fortnightly on Wednesdays. It is sponsored by PAYCE and so is provided at no cost to parents/carers. A permission note is not required as it covers the school curriculum and is cost free.

Seed Harvest Spoon is a registered 'Not for Profit' organisation which provides a hands-on sustainability education program based around our Kitchen Garden. The program links with the NSW curriculum outcomes and encompasses literacy, science, numeracy, creativity and health content through hands-on experiences in the garden and kitchen environment. #### Science: Skyworks Planetarium (3-6)

This incursion will be held in the school hall on Monday September 2<sup>nd</sup> and costs \$8.

The Skyworks Planetarium is a portable Planetarium Dome that allows students to explore the night sky through projection. This spectacular display of the earth, solar systems, stars, constellations and the universe will mesmerise one and all as they crawl through this captivating dome while the presenter's commentary engages them from start to finish.

#### Musica Viva – Rhythm Works (K-6)

This incursion will be held in the school hall on Wednesday September 4th and costs \$9.

Rhythm Works are a dynamic percussion duo who show students how to create visual images through music – with lizards, waterfalls, road trains, and carnivals. In this high energy show, students are introduced to a range of instruments from African djembes, marimbas, electronic loop machines, laptops, Boomwhackers, and wearable instruments made out of PVC pipe! Students are given opportunities to perform on these instruments to create their own musical imagery, with opportunities to re-create the experience back in the home or classroom.

#### Drama: Room On Our Rock, Book Week Performance (K-6)

This incursion will be held in the school hall on Wednesday September 11th and costs \$8.

To celebrate 2019 Book Week, Meerkat Productions will be presenting an adaptation of Kate and Jol Temple's picture book, illustrated by Terri Rose Baynton, *Room On Our Rock. Room On Our Rock* focuses on the themes of sharing and empathy for others. Their adaptation plays the arrival of the two frightened seals from an endangered rock twice over from two different points of view.

#### Geography Excursion: Changing Landscapes Beneath Our Feet (Years 3 & 4)

This excursion will be held at the Fisherman's Beach, Long Reef on Thursday September 26th. The cost is \$35.

Students will have the opportunity to explore why and how our coastal landscape is changing. They will gain a deeper understanding of how and why geological changes can occur through the following hands on activities including weather testing, rock investigation and dune investigation. A guided walk around the headland gives students the opportunity to observe and reflect on the cause and effect of both natural and man-made changes. Students will partake in a guided exploration of Long Reef rock pool and discover the abundance of species that survive in this unique and challenging intertidal habitat. Students will experience first-hand how the physical conditions of the environment affect the marine invertebrates that live there.

#### Presentation Day Rehearsal and Presentation Day (K-6)

These excursions will be held at Marsden High School on the morning of Thursday December 5<sup>th</sup> and afternoon of Thursday December 12<sup>th</sup>. There is no cost.

At the end of each school year we take the time to recognise the wonderful achievements our students have made with a presentation assembly. Parents and families are invited to congratulate students on academic, social, sporting and creative progress. The school Dux, Sportsperson of the Year and Creative Arts trophies are awarded and the school leaders for the following year are announced.





### Celebration Café (K-6)

This activity will be held at school on Tuesday December 17th and costs \$10.
